The Difference between Race and Ethnicity

On your Patient Registration form, you will notice blanks for **race** and **ethnicity**. This information is important for our records and may be important in determining your diagnosis, ordering labs, and gathering other health information. Below you will find definitions to help you discern between these terms.

Race: Race relates to a person's physical appearance and is usually defined by the color of the skin. It is determined biologically, with genetic traits such as hair color, eye color, and bone structure.

Ethnicity: Ethnicity relates to the cultural factors you may use to identify yourself, such as nationality, culture, ancestry, language, or beliefs.
